

Academic Unit Review: 7-Year Schedule

CapU's second cycle of centrally supported academic review begins in the 2023-24 academic year (AY). Year 1 of the second cycle starts with two snapshot surveys: one for annual academic unit data and a second for curriculum and learning data. Information collected in the snapshots will roll up into cyclical academic unit review (every 7 years) and will support annual academic unit planning activities.¹
