### 7.2.1 S1999-06 Faculty Emeritus Policy

Senate was requested to approve revisions to S1999-06 Faculty Emeritus Policy. The Policy is being revised as a result of a recommendation from the Senate Tributes Committee to increase the retirement period from two to three years before a nominee can be considered for a Faculty Emeritus designation. The Emeritus designation recognizes services to one's discipline and the University before and after retirement and as such, the three-year period would be the minimum to establish an ongoing record of service after retirement.

### 8.1 Chair of Senate

Paul Dangerfield, Chair of Senate, provided the following report:

- Paul will be attending Mt. Currie campus to celebrate with the Lil'wat Nation the opening of the New Learning Centre.
- The bi-annual President's Perspective will be held on Thursday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Bosa Centre. Topics will include the University's priorities for 2019/2020, the key priority for 2020 in addressing domestic student enrollment, as well as highlights of the Integrated Plan and Envisioning 2030.
- With respect to the new campus in Lower Lonsdale, tenant improvements are not yet completed; however, it is anticipated a soft launch of the campus will take place in October and the official grand opening in November.
- Several orientations are scheduled for the coming week which will result in many new students, faculty and employees finding their way around campus, and members were encouraged to provide any assistance as required.

Stephen Williams, Vice-Chair of Senate, reported that a call will be made to fill student representative and other vacancies on the Senate subcommittees.

- As part of the Universities Canada application, the University will be moving forward with a site visit this fall or early January (site visit dates have not yet been confirmed), and various areas across the University will be engaged to prepare for the site visit.
- In terms of new programs, 19 new credentials are in various stages of planning and development.
- Some vacant positions have recently been filled, including Lara Duke, new Dean of the Faculty of Global & Community Studies and Aurelea Mahood, Director Academic Initiatives and Planning.
- Active searches continue with respect to filling vacant positions including the Regional Director, Sunshine Coast and Director for Indigenous Education and Affairs.
