Steven Atkins - Director

Dr. Stephen Atkins is a director, performer, acting teacher and devised theatre practitioner specialising in self scripting techniques such as the one used for this show. Atkins was born in Canada and is based in the UK and Australia. He has trained in London, Los Angeles and New York City, and is affiliated the Meisner Estate Studio (USA), the National Michael Chekhov Association (USA) and the Mary Overlie Foundation for the Viewpoints. He has taught performance in 6 countries worldwide for over 30 years and recently published Crosspoints: An Integrative Acting System (2020).



Junita Thiessen - Assistant Director

Junita Thiessen is a multi-disciplinary artist, and a queer, femme, Asian woman. Acting for Stage and Screen program graduate, Fabulist Theatre artistic associate, director of audio series "BLOOD RAGE MODE", karaoke live-streamer and actor. Itai Erdel- Lighting Designer
